

February 13

6. Mid-semester examination

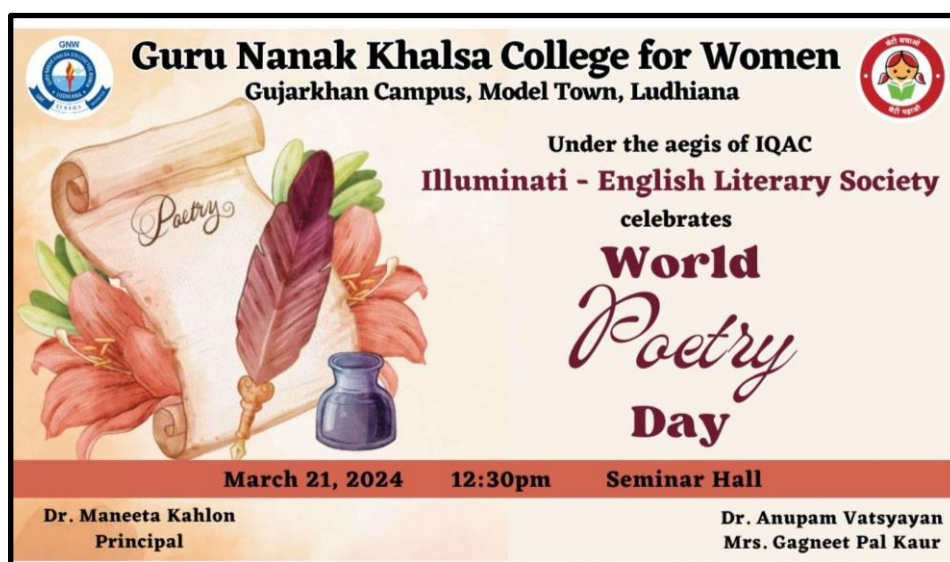
March 18 to April 01

April 16-23

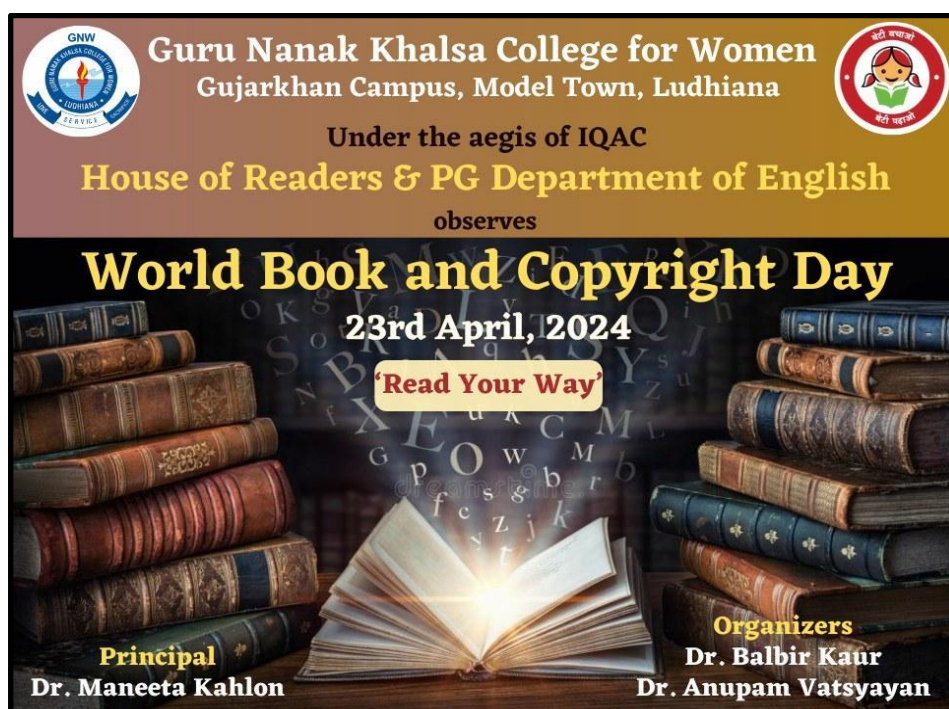
