2.2.1 THE INSTITUTION ASSESSES THE LEARNING LEVELS OF STUDENTS AND ORGANIZES SPECIAL PROGRAMS FOR ADVANCED LEARNERS AND SLOW LEARNERS

Each student is unique with different abilities and capabilities, for assessment we analyse them as Advanced and Slow learners. Advanced learners are students who grasp topics faster than their peers and typically score high marks, demonstrating strong academic understanding. In contrast, slow learners face challenges in keeping up with the pace of the curriculum due to various factors, such as socio-economic background, lack of motivation, or difficulty in the medium of instruction.

At GNKCW, admission is merit-based, ensuring a mix of bright and average students. To support all students in adjusting to the learning environment, the institution implements a range of initiatives designed to cater to both advanced and slow learners.

OBJECTIVES:

- To develop strategies that benefit both advanced and slow learners.
- To encourage advanced learners to achieve excellence.
- To foster an innovative and creative mindset among students.
- To bridge the gap between slow and advanced learners.
- To organize workshops and seminars for the benefit of both groups.

MEASURES TAKEN:

1. **Equal Opportunity Cell:** The Equal Opportunity Cell ensures that students from diverse communal, regional, and economic backgrounds have equal access to the college's resources and infrastructure. The cell focuses on affirmative action for students from SC/ST/OBC, minority communities, and physically challenged students. For slow learners, the cell conducts remedial classes and provides academic, social, and psychological counseling to help them overcome barriers to learning.
2. **Parent-Teacher Meetings:** Regular parent-teacher meetings (PTMs) provide a platform for discussing students' academic performance and well-being. If a student is facing difficulties, teachers inform the parents promptly. PTMs are held at the end of each

semester, where mentors meet with parents to discuss strengths, areas for improvement, and suggestions for supporting student development. Inputs from parents are carefully considered and, where feasible, implemented by the management.

3. **Mentor-Mentee System:** The college has a structured mentorship system where each student is assigned a faculty mentor. Mentors track their mentees' academic progress, provide emotional and professional support, and maintain regular communication with parents. This system helps identify both slow and advanced learners early on. For slow learners, mentors offer personalized guidance, remedial support, and referrals to other subject-specific teachers for additional help. Advanced learners are encouraged to pursue academic excellence and provided with platforms for professional growth. Mentors also focus on understanding the socio-economic challenges that may affect students' performance and offer appropriate interventions.

4. **Library Facility:** The college library is accessible to all students, providing an extensive range of resources to support learning. Both slow and advanced learners can borrow books and reference materials to aid their preparation and broaden their knowledge base. The library supports students in their academic endeavors by offering additional resources for in-depth study and exam preparation.

IDENTIFICATION OF SLOW AND ADVANCED LEARNERS:

The institution uses a variety of parameters to identify slow and advanced learners, which are closely monitored by mentors:

- Classroom Participation

INITIATIVES FOR ADVANCED LEARNERS:

For advanced learners, the college offers several specialized activities to enhance their academic growth and professional development:

- **Recognition:** Advanced learners are motivated to strive for university ranks, and semester toppers are recognized and honored.
- **Academic Competitions:** They are encouraged to participate in academic activities like quizzes, presentations, and group discussions.
- **Career Planning:** Students are guided in career planning and provided opportunities for internships, research, and skill development.
- **Peer Learning:** Advanced learners are encouraged to help slower peers, fostering a culture of peer learning and mutual support.
- **Leadership Opportunities:** They are nominated as members of college clubs, societies, and the student council, encouraging them to develop leadership skills.

INITIATIVES FOR SLOW LEARNERS:

For slow learners, a range of support measures are implemented to assist them in overcoming academic challenges:

- **Remedial Classes:** Extra classes are organized to help slow learners catch up with the curriculum.
- **Personalized Attention:** Mentors provide individual attention to address specific learning needs.
- **Special Coaching and Counseling:** Mentors and the counseling cell offer additional coaching, support, and counseling to help slow learners improve their academic performance and build confidence.
- **Practice Materials:** Previous years' question papers and question banks are made available to slow learners to aid in exam preparation.
- **Reinforced Practice:** Repeated practice on important topics and questions helps slow learners solidify their understanding and improve their performance.

By implementing these strategies, the institution ensures that all students—whether advanced or slow learners—are provided with the necessary resources, guidance, and support to succeed in their academic journey.

ACTIVITY: ANNUAL PRIZE DISTRIBUTION

- **August 18, 2023:** Placement Cell organized seminar for the final year's students of B.Com, BCA and B.B.A. Mr.Kawaljeet from Bajaj Finserv limited was the resource person. He explained the students about the Certificate programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance offered by Bajaj Finserv limited Pune. This programme has been designed for fresh graduates and final year students aspiring to build career in financial service sector. After successfully completed this course, students will be able to apply in private banks as well as non-banking financial companies for entry level positions in sales, customer care and financial services.
- **September 06, 2023:** Placement Cell of Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women in collaboration with Hit Bullseye Ludhiana and TiE Chandigarh organized "FUTURE BUSINESS SHARKS" contests for the students of BBA and BCom in the campus. The contest was conducted in two rounds .Online test was conducted which included interesting case studies and questions based on critical thinking. A Quiz was also conducted to check the business aptitude and corporate awareness of students. Exciting gifts and goodies were awarded to prize winners.
- **September 26, 2023:** Placement cell organised an extension lecture on the topic "Mastering interview skills is the key to unlocking doors to your dream career" for commerce and Management students .The Resource person were Mr. Manbir Singh, an International Education Expert and Mr Parvit Behl, Assistant Manager,AECC Global,Ludhiana. The resource persons educated the students about the different resume writing skills which will be helpful for their careers. They apprised the students about the various interview strategies . They conducted various activities to give practical aspects of interview and how to face it in this competitive world.

- **September 28, 2023:** Placement Cell of Guru Nanak Khalsa College for Women organized Scholarship Test by IBS, ICFAI Business School under the guidance of placement officers, Dr Neetu Prakash and Dr Nidhi Sharma. The In-charge of IBS Mr. Madho Singh Randhawa educated the students about various competitive exams and how to prepare them with the help of proper guidance and practice. The team of IBS conducted this Scholarship test for the students of B.Com, B.B.A and B.C.A and discussed various career opportunities available to them through this Scholarship test.
- **January 20, 2024:** Placement cell organized a seminar on the topic "Career advancement and personality development" for commerce and Management students. The Resource person was Ms Harpreet Kaur, Assistant Manager - Australia - Punjab, SIEC Education, Ludhiana. The resource person educated the students about the different Career options after graduation and discusses personality development skills which will be helpful for their careers. They apprised the students about the various interview strategies. They conducted various activities to give practical aspects of interview and how to face it in this competitive world.
- **January 30, 2023:** Placement Cell in collaboration with My Virtual Teams initiated a placement drive in the college campus for all final year students. The company deals in customized e-commerce sites, mobile apps, AI apps, software's, IoT, Data Analytics, DevOps, Cloud and Block chain services. The placement drive was conducted in 3 steps starting with a brief presentation about the company by the director, followed by written test and interview. The recruitment was done for the positions of technical as well as non-technical areas such as Associate Software developer, project coordinator, Business Analyst, HR executive, graphic designer and UI/UX designer. 46 students from diverse streams participated in the drive. 30 students were selected for the interview round and finally 3 students got the offer letter for the position of MERN stack developer.
- **February 02, 2024:** Placement Cell organized a Career Counseling seminar on job opportunities in the government sector. Mr. Dev Raj, Branch Head, AAA Bright Academy, Ludhiana was the resource person. He apprised the students of various job opportunities in



the government sector such as UPSC, SSC CGL, SSC LDC, IBPS PO, RBI, Insurance, PSPCL, PUNSUP and allied. He talked about the benefits of government sector jobs that include handsome salary, job security, work life balance etc. He also discussed the syllabus of various competitive exams and upcoming vacancies in government sector.

- **February 26, 2024:** Placement Cell of the college in collaboration with Maya Academy of Advanced Creativity (MAAC) organized a seminar on " New Age Career Options in Media and Entertainment Industry " Ms Riya Arora, Director, MAAC Ludhiana was the resource person. Ms Arora is a motivational speaker who inspired the students on how to overcome day to day challenges of life and explore their full potential. She apprised the students about the scope of Animation, graphics , 3D, VFX video editing, gaming etc and various career options in media and entertainment industry. Mr. Baljit Singh (faculty) and Mr.Rachhpal Singh (Business Development Manager) were also part of the event.
- **March 01, 2024:** Placement Cell in collaboration with Micro Small and Medium Enterprises Development and Facilitation Office, Ludhiana organized Entrepreneurship Awareness Program on Self- Employment Opportunities in the college campus today.
