# 3.2 - Innovation Ecosystem

# **3.2.1** - Institution has created an ecosystem for innovations and has initiatives for creation and transfer of knowledge

Under the inspiring leadership of Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon, the academic year 2023-24 witnessed several initiatives designed to enhance entrepreneurial skills and introduce progressive learning practices.

Faculty members were encouraged to adopt innovative teaching methods, making the learning process more engaging and dynamic. A range of curricular and extracurricular programs, at both departmental and institutional levels, connected students with industry professionals, fostering a collaborative environment for creativity and knowledge sharing.

The college provided a stimulating atmosphere that nurtured students' inventive abilities. ## **Building up Entrepreneurial Skills**

#### Earn While You Learn Scheme (with Exhibitions and Counter sales set-up by the students)

Cognizant of this, the college invests in the **faculty development program for the bright future of their students and future-ready faculty members**. In addition, teachers are provided with **seed funding** to support their **professional development and academic growth**. This funding enables them to undertake research projects, participate in workshops, attend

Faculty Development Programs, and enroll in various specialized courses. These initiatives aim to enhance their knowledge, skills, and expertise in their respective fields.

The following FDPs/ Training workshops were organized by the college during the session 2023-24:
