To observe World Cycle day



Registration drive







Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon encouraged students to become conscientious road users, contributing to the creation of a secure and considerate community.








Voter Awareness Activities at GNKCW

Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon motivated the students to be a part of this initiative taken by the Election Commission of India and participate in the electoral process.








Road Safety and Traffic rules Awareness Week at GNKCW

Principal of the college, Dr. Maneeta Kahlon motivated students to focus on their mental health and should consult a doctor or a counsellor for help.




World Cancer Day




World Tuberculosis Day


Free Blood Test Camp at GNKCW





GNKCW organizes National Anti-Terrorism Day
