

2. Participated in Quiz Competition










4. Organized Yoga Session for students





Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon appreciated the efforts of the department to encourage students to participate in sports and fitness events and instill positivity and harmony in society.




The theme of the Second week of September (From September 09-15) is to find out the degree of malnutrition and to fight back the symptoms by introducing millet meals.

Principal Dr Maneeta Kahlon motivated the students to follow the foot steps of Bhai Ghanaiya ji






14.Gandhi Jayanti


• Students highlighted their thoughts on the "Significance of keeping the surroundings Clean" through Essay writing competition.



Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon encouraged the cadets and volunteers to participate in such type of activities.





27.Seminar on Mental Wellness at GNKCW





28.Eye Check-up Camp at GNKCW



Principal, Dr. Maneeta Kahlon encouragement and gratitude towards the club and hospital further acknowledge their valuable contribution to the event.















Activity Details:






Activity: International Youth Day celebrations








Kargil Vijay Diwas






Cadets celebrated Vijay Diwas








4. Indian Army Day








7. Student achievements for the month of January 2024

8.NCC 'B' & 'C' certificate exams



10. Yuva Sangam Program


