A personality with multifarious talents and an orator par excellence, Principal Madam is a social influencer who receives invites from various institutions as Resource Person for conferences and workshops. She is a role model for all the faculty members and her able guidance, staff members actively participated in various workshops and seminars .The research papers of faculty members were published in UGC notified list of journals, UGC care list of journals and SCOPUS during the academic period 2024-25(July to December). Apart from these, College also awarded seminars from the reputed national level organisations. Not only staff members, students of the college also got research experience by actively participated in various seminars and visited many industrial units and corporate houses.

SEMINARS AND EXTENSION LECTURERS ORGANISED UNDER IQAC

- GST Day was observed in the college on July 1, 2024. This day marks the anniversary of the implementation of GST in India. Mrs. Manpreet Kaur, Assistant Professor, was the resource person for the event. She explained the different types of GST and the benefits of its implementation for both the government and the public. Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon emphasized that this taxation system has contributed to economic growth and increased tax revenue for the government.
- International Plastic Bag Free Day was observed in the college on July 03, 2024.An awareness session was organized to promote environmental sustainability and the reduction of plastic waste. The seminar was convened by Dr. Nidhi Sharma and Ms. Daisy Wadhwa, club coordinators, who emphasized the urgent need to minimize plastic usage and adopt eco-friendly alternatives. Students highlighted the adverse effects of single-use plastics and the importance of making conscious choices to protect our planet. Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon commended the initiative, stating, "Plastic pollution is a critical issue that demands immediate attention. It is imperative for young minds to lead the way in advocating for a plastic-free world. Today's session is a step towards raising awareness and instilling a sense of responsibility towards our environment."
- World Population Day was observed on July 11, 2024 with great enthusiasm and purpose. Mrs. Seema Dua, the Head of the Department of Economics, elaborated the theme of the day "leave no one behind, Count everyone, ensuring accurate counts" of all people worldwide. Population Day, which aims to raise awareness about global population issues. She also discussed in detail the various challenges posed by overpopulation, including the strain on natural resources, increased pollution, and the pressure on public services such as healthcare and education. She emphasized the importance of family planning, sustainable development, and the need for policies that address population growth effectively. Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon shared her perspective on the challenges of population explosion. Dr. Kahlon expressed concerns over the rapid increase in population and its implications on economic and social development. 

INDUSTRIAL VISITS

- An industrial visit was arranged for the M.Com-I students to Neva Garments Ltd., Ludhiana. on July 25,2024. The main purpose of this visit was to provide practical exposure to industrial operations and management practices to the students. They were given a comprehensive tour of the factory, beginning with an overview of the company's history, mission, and current market position. It included visits to the production facilities, where students observed the manufacturing process, quality control measures, and safety protocols. Additionally, interaction sessions with department heads and managers were conducted to discuss various aspects such as production planning, quality control methods, and the different accounts/job cards prepared by the various departments. The visit was organized by Mrs. Maninder Kaur (Head of the Department) and Mrs. Manmeet Kaur, Associate Professor. Dr. Kuldeep Kaur and Ms. Chakshu accompanied the students. Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon emphasized that the college is committed to providing educational experiences. Such learning opportunities play a crucial role in preparing students for the challenges of the modern business world.
- An Industrial Visit to Verka Milk Plant, Ferozpur Road, Ludhiana was arranged by the college on August 14, 2024. Students of BBA 2nd and 3rd year visited the production plant of Verka. Mrs. Dalbir kaur (Assistant Manager) along with Ms. Navdeep Kaur (Assistant Manager) of the plant enlightened the students about processing of Verka Milk right from the collection by Co-operative Societies to different Silos inside the plant. They acquainted the students with the current capacity of the plant that is nine lakh liters per day. In addition to this students were also made aware about the production process of other items like table butter, curd, ghee, milk powder etc along with their packaging process. Students had a great experience by knowing the importance of human resources as well as the machinery in an organisation.
- The PG Department of Commerce, Department of BCA and Department of OMSP organized an educational visit to the screening of the historical and spiritual movie Bibi Rajni on September 10, 2024, September 14, 2024 and September 24, 2024 respectively in an effort to enrich students' understanding of history and cultural heritage. The movie, known for its accurate portrayal of significant historical events, provided the students with a visual and engaging experience of history beyond textbooks. An interactive session with the production and quality control managers provided an opportunity for students to ask questions and gain deeper insights into production challenges and quality assurance processes. The visit concluded with a briefing on key operational aspects, such as supply chain management and marketing strategies. The students and faculty expressed their sincere gratitude to S. Harminder Singh Ji for granting permission for the visit, and to Madam Principal Dr. Maneeta Kahlon for her support in organizing this enriching educational experience.
